## Dues are coming Due

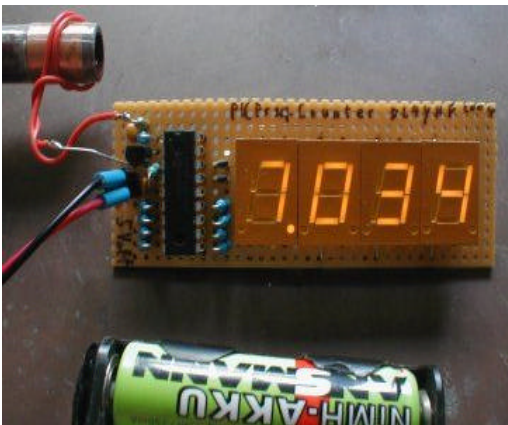

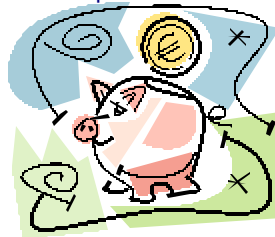
