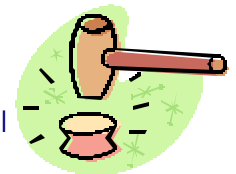

### 1987

HARC officers of the club for the year were: President-KA7FJX, Carroll; Vice President-W7BKO, Bernie; Secretary-KA7YHV, Sharon; Treasurer-KA7CED, Rosy. Board members were KA7HIO, Cheryl; KD7AM, Yoshi; N7HIL, Bill; and KA7YFY, Kent.

April meeting was headlined as "Packet Racket" with KA7AGH, Jim; WB7AUF, Art; and W7BKO, Bernie, making the presentation.

HARC's August campout was scheduled for Ft. Stevens. KA7SKL, Tary, handled the details.

HARC members participated in the Northwest Amateur Radio Council sponsored license exams at Portland Community College campus.

Due to lack of interest in the Repeater Association, the Repeater Association was disbanding with its funds turned over to HARC. KA7IUG, Cory submitted a repeater committee plan that was approved by the HARC membership. Multnomah Cable Access approached HARC about producing a show on "Amateur Radio". KB7DIV, Steve Hache, contacted the club.








