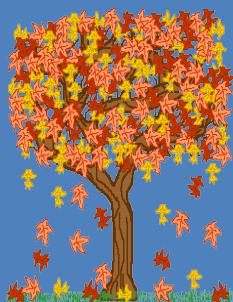

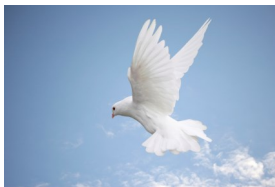
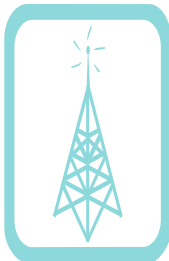

Crossroads Church, 2505 NE 102nd Avenue, Portland.

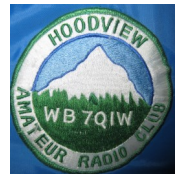

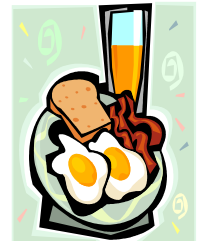
## Patches, Hats, Badges
