HOW TO APPLY

1. Visit mhcc.edu/Scholarships and select Apply Now
2. Sign in to the scholarship portal using your MyMHCC login and password.
3. Complete the General Application. This one application will be used to automatically match you to available MHCC scholarships.
4. Check your Saints email. Scholarship recipients will be notified on or before November 22, 2019.

The Mt. Hood Community College Foundation awards over **\$400,000** in scholarships to MHCC students each year. Any new or continuing student who plans to attend MHCC during the 2019-20 school year is eligible to apply. Complete one online application to be considered for all available MHCC scholarships!

NEW MHCC STUDENTS must apply for admission before completing the scholarship application. The admissions application is free and does not commit you to attending MHCC. Visit mhcc.edu/Admission to apply. You will receive your MyMHCC login information via email within 1-2 business days.

APPLICATION TIPS

References: Find two references (teachers, coaches, advisors, supervisors, coworkers, etc.) and ask if they would be willing to provide a recommendation

for your scholarship application. References must use the scholarship portal to submit their recommendations. Enter the name and email address of each reference into your application and the portal will send them a link to sign in and submit a recommendation.

Use the **References** tab at the top of the scholarship portal to check the status of your references. Follow-up to make sure they respond by the deadline.

Transcripts: If you are new to MHCC, upload an unofficial transcript from the last school you attended (high school or college). This transcript will be used to determine your GPA. If you are a GED graduate, upload your GED transcripts.

Returning students do not need to upload an unofficial transcript. If you have already completed at least one graded course at MHCC, your GPA will be imported from your student record. You can view your cumulative GPA by clicking on the **Applicant Record** button in the lower left corner of the application.

Essays: There are four essay questions on the scholarship application. Each response is limited to 200 words (about 1-2 paragraphs). Invest time in writing thoughtful essays – they make up the majority of your application score!

Have someone review your essays before you submit them. Visit the MHCC AVID Writing Center for assistance. See **mhcc.edu/**

1. What are your specific educational plans and career goals and why? What inspires you to achieve them?
2. What have you done for your family or community that you care about the most and why?
3. Describe a personal accomplishment and the strengths and skills you used to achieve it.
4. Describe a significant change or experience that has occurred in your life. How did you respond and what did you learn about yourself?
