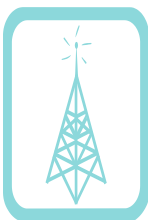

Hoodview Simplex Frequency

Did you know that if our repeater goes down during an emergency or is being used by MCARES, that the members of Hoodview Amateur Radio Club should check in on the 443.475 repeater or use 147.48 Simplex and 147.52 Simplex? We will monitor those frequencies to offer assistance if available.

Hoodview's Simplex Net

Twice a month we are trying out a simplex net. This is a fun way to prepare for no repeater coverage just in case we are without the added help of our repeaters. Participation fluctuates each time but the hams who are checking in are getting better at this form of communication. It is great test of our gear and see who we could hear. We would like to encourage more people to check in to the simplex net.

Our next one will be held on Tuesday September 21st at 7:30 PM on 147.480 MHz. If 147.480 MHz is in use, the alternate frequency of 147.520 MHz will be used. Monitor the repeater, if possible, for any announcements of frequency changes.

We look forward to hearing from as many people as possible who would like to test out their equipment and learn a fascinating method for communication in a net format.

VE Testing for Ham Licenses

You are **REQUIRED** to register in the FCC CORES system and receive a FCC Registration Number (FRN) before exam day. Candidates could go directly to the FCC CORES User Account and Registration page: <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do>. VECs are required by the FCC to submit your FRN with your license application form. New license applicants should create an FCC user account and register their Social Security Number (SSN) in the FCC Commission Registration System (CORES) before attending exam sessions. Registrants will be assigned an FRN which will be used in all license transactions with the FCC. Also, effective in June an amateur radio licensee must provide the FCC with an email address on all applications. If no email address is included, the FCC may dismiss the application as "defective." Once an email address is provided, the FCC will email a link to an official electronic copy of the license grant. An official copy will also be available at any time by accessing the licensee's password-protected Universal Licensing System account.
