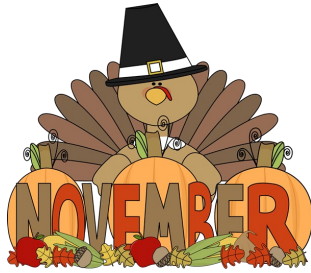

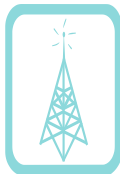

VE Testing for Ham Licenses



An amateur radio licensee must provide the FCC with an email address on all applications. If no email address is included, the FCC may dismiss the application as defective. The FCC will email a link to an official electronic copy of the license grant. An official copy will be available by accessing the licensee's password-protected Universal Licensing System account. You must also register in the FCC CORES system and receive a FCC Registration Number before exam day. Candidates could go directly to the FCC CORES User Account and Registration page: <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do>. VECs are required to submit your FRN with your license application form. New license applicants should create an FCC user account and register their social security number in the FCC Commission Registration System before attending exams. Registrants will be assigned an FRN which will be used in all license transactions with the FCC.

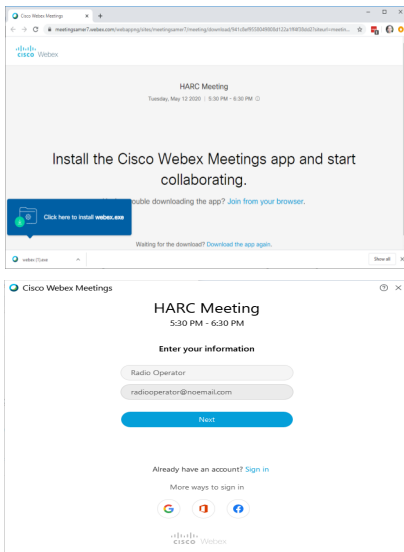

Joining a HARC WebEx Virtual Meeting

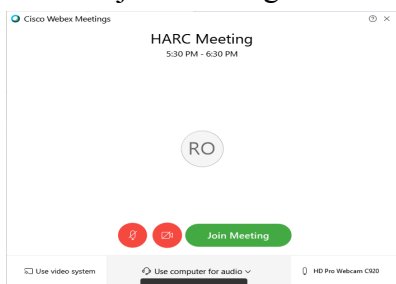

Click the 'Join Meeting' link in the email you received from Hoodview Amateur Radio Club. You will be prompted to download the WebEx Meeting Client. Once it is downloaded open the file.

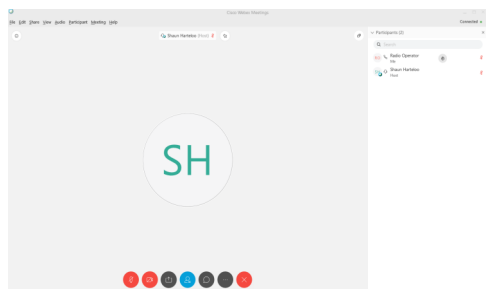


1. You will get a new window that asks for your name and email address. Enter your name and an email address, as this allows us to track attendees.
2. Click on next and then select to disable video and mute your microphone. This is a best practice for HARC meetings to reduce background noise and bandwidth

usage. You can use your computer for audio or dial in with a telephone. Select from the drop down in the middle what you plan on doing and follow the instructions. The call in details will pop up once you click on join meeting.

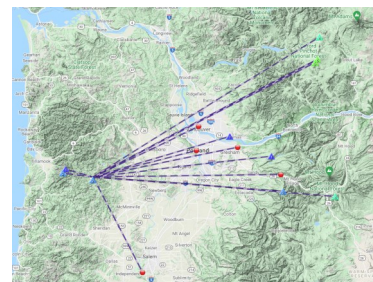
Hoodview ARC SOTA S2S Party

Saturday Oct 30th was a Hoodview ARC SOTA Summit to Summit party. Several club members got out on a very windy but sunny day to "activate" summits and several more members encouraged them by "chasing" them for SOTA points.

Joel, N7LF was able to accomplish a "1st Activation" of Lookout Point ([W7O/WV-079](#)) due to obtaining special permission to access the summit for which public access is not permitted. Joel got 20 QSOs and wrote up a [trip report available here](#). Joe (WB7VTY) activated Prune Hill ([W7W/LC-164](#)) and was unable to hide from a ferocious East wind. The wind took a toll on one of his antennas, but he was still able to successfully activate (get more than 4 QSOs) using his handheld. Greg (KJ7EHA) headed out to the North Coast range and activated Trask Mountain ([W7O/NC-003](#)) and managed 20 QSOs with 9 of them S2S (summit to summit). SOTA Map of the activation shown below. It turns out that with the chaser points Greg got from the S2S QSOs he crossed the 1000 chaser points needed to officially become a SOTA "Shack Sloth." Activators were able to get contacts with some of the SOTA regulars you'll hear on local summits. Roland (K7FOP) and Etienne (K7ATN) were on Wildcat Mountain ([W7O/WV-046](#)) and K7AHR (Anne) and N7KOM (Tim) did a double activation over in the Lower Columbia of [East Crater](#) and [Gifford Peak](#). Two more regulars headed farther west in the North Coast and did a mountain bike activation of [Edwards Butte](#) and a "1st activation" of [Summit 2730](#) (some summits don't have names only number for altitude).

A big thank you to all the chasers as well. Activators stayed on 146.580 because it turned out we did not have as many activators as we thought we might, so everyone stayed on 146.580 where other chasers and activators were. Apologies to those who were waiting for us to QSY over to 146.560. We will work to improve our process next time.

Anyone interested in future activations, send email to KJ7EHA@arrl.net, its rainy season now, but there will be days here and there with good opportunities. Winter bonus points for summits begins on December 1st, and there will be also be ski/snowshoe activations coming up.
