#### From the President's Desk - Rob Remler K7MR

Have you heard about Ham Radio? I've been having conversations about ham radio with some friends and groups who are not hams and inviting them to try the hobby and the responses have been interesting. Many spoke about the code requirements (that went away 15+ years ago) and others dismiss it for how much time they think it takes to study and get a license. Some simply stated "why?". I went to the internet looking for more information or conversation about why people are not interested in Ham Radio and came across a few articles that described why some are not joining our hobby.

One conversation talked about most people having cell phones now and the "need" for radio has been replaced, especially with the inclusion of the internet in the pocket of most people. Most have not experienced and outage or situation where cell coverage was interrupted for an extended period of time or a natural disaster that has interrupted the infrastructure and needed communication has not been available.

Cost was talked about as a reason some don't consider our hobby. While it's true some "use to have money but now have radios" there are ways to enter the hobby without breaking the bank. If you are a new Ham, check out <a href="www.qrz.com">www.qrz.com</a> and look at their "New Ham Jumpstart Program".

One consistent point that was made is the public perception of our Hobby. One article from QRPblog made an interesting statement:

Stop showing people keying CW at 40wpm as if that defines our hobby; stop talking about the F-layer and how to calculate a dipole length. Focus on a simpler and clearer message about what we do, that is interesting and relevant to a wider audience. Educate instead of focusing on showing off your knowledge and jargon.

I'm not pointing at anyone else but I know that it has been easy for me to slip into the technical speak that hams often do even when talking to new hams or those who just seem to be interested.

As Field Day approaches and we invite the public to come see and hear what we do I'm hoping to keep my conversations simple and inviting. I'm looking forward to hanging out with others who enjoy similar interests and would love to share our hobby with those who may stop by.

**VE Testing for Ham Licenses:** An licensee must provide the FCC with an email address on all applications. If no email address is included, the FCC may dismiss the application. The FCC will email a link



to an official electronic copy of the license grant. An official copy will be available by accessing the licensee's password-protected Universal Licensing System account. You must also register in the FCC CORES system and receive a FCC Registration Number before exam day. Candidates could go directly to the FCC CORES User Account and Registration page: https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do. Applicants should create an FCC user account and register their social security number in the FCC Commission Registration System before attending exams. Registrants will be assigned an FRN which will be used in all license transactions with the FCC. The current cost for taking a test is \$15 at the examination time. Plus you will be assessed a \$35 from the FCC which must be paid within ten days.
