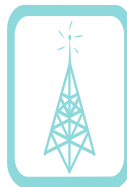
Watch for your electronic birthday card in your email. E-cards sent to members with active email addresses and birthday provided to the club.

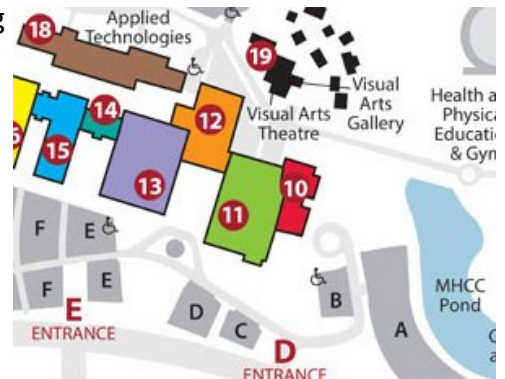
Renewing Your Dues
