

WB7QIW—Help Wanted for Online-Tech Meeting

Two or three members who can regularly attend the club meeting to setup and run a club laptop, webcam, and hand out microphones. Any necessary training will be "on the job." At the October Board Meeting, the board discussed improving online meetings. Online is important for a number of our members; some are home-bound, and it is difficult to get out, personal mobility and hearing is hard for some. Sometimes, attending virtually is an advantage. Without online meetings, some members would be shut out of the club.

The board discussed needing better and updated equipment, and we agreed that it would be worthwhile. But we realized that if we got the equipment, it would be a burden if we didn't also have the people to run it. We need a lead person (chairmen of the Tech-Online Committee) to be primary point of contact with one or two backup people to help, and to cover when the lead person isn't available.

The plan would be to start with what we have and to learn what we need to do. Then to identify and get additional equipment to improve video and audio. Also to use WebEx features to improve production as it seems appropriate.

End result would be online and local meetings will be integrated, everyone will have choices available, and everyone in the club can attend the meeting, if they wish.
