

Electronic Testing for New Licenses

We are still testing those people with FRN numbers!

With the help of the free ExamTools website, it couldn't be easier or faster for HARC to offer inperson testing. People start by using the "Find A Session" list at HamStudy.org to get registered for a test session and get their payment submitted. When they

arrive on-site they get checked in, seated at a PC, and then are able to get started. The new system is able to provide them immediate feedback once they have passed and the VEs electronically sign their CSCE (Certificate of Successful Completion of Examination). Once the examination session is completed, the VE Team submits the data to the ARRL electronically as well which drastically improves how quickly new licenses and upgrades appear in the FCC database (sometimes within two business days).

MHCC has been very helpful and is allowing HARC to use the computer lab across from the classroom at the Fisheries Building.

If you are an Amateur Extra license holder and would like to help our VE team reach out to me at ve@wb7qiw.org and I'll help get you set up.

The next exam session for the Hoodview ARC VE team will be on November 15, 2025 at 9:00 AM at Mt Hood Community College Fisheries #1, Gresham, OR 97030.


Treasurer's Report:
